Ridgeland Forest Swim and Racquet COVID-19 Policies

Members

We want to provide our community with an environment where everyone feels safe to relax and enjoy the pool. Once we have received your completed membership application, Swim at Own Risk waiver and COVID-19 waiver, the gate code to the pool and tennis courts will be emailed to you.

You are entering at your own risk.

The RFSRC Board has reached out to local health authorities and other local neighborhood pools for directives and guidelines as we prepare to open our pool. The RFSRC Board determined that we will make our best efforts to follow the recommendations/mandates by the Gwinnett County Department of Health in order to provide a safe environment for all members while on pool grounds. We have created a plan to keep everyone safe and we are excited about opening.

Life at the pool will be different. We have had to make difficult decisions about how we use the pool and grounds. Please be respectful to your fellow members by following these guidelines. Members are asked to spread out & follow social distancing rules.

For community safety we do ask that members do not enter club property if they or anyone in our household, or anyone they have come in contact with, are exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms (i.e. cough, shortness of breath, fever, chills, muscle pain, or sore throat, among other symptoms). **IF you have had a fever or been sick, please stay at home and not attend the pool until symptom free for 14 days.**

2020 POOL Hours 9AM -8PM

Senior hours (60+) from 9AM-10AM, 7 days a week, for our members who are encouraged to shelter in place until June 12th. After that time, we will determine if we need to extend the senior hours past June 12th. No other children nor families are permitted during senior hours.

10-1 - Appointment only single or two family appointments available) See our website to make an appointment.

1-8 Swim At Your Own Risk (until lifeguards are able to be certified, which is currently unavailable as county pools are still closed.) We will have a monitor at the pool for routine cleaning.

If the following guidelines are not followed, the Board reserves the right to suspend memberships or close the pool to all members.

- A maximum of 5 guests per family are permitted, however, **each group can be no larger than 10 people.** If your family in attendance is comprised of 6 or more, you must limit your party to a maximum of 10 people in attendance. No exceptions. Guest fees will be paid online only, no cash will be accepted or received.
- At this time, no minors will be allowed at pool without an adult member of their household.

- **ALL Members will sign in and sign out indicating the time they were at the pool (so if someone were to become infected, we will know the members that attended during a specific time)**

DPH requirements and recommendations.

- Detailed signage will be on display throughout the pool deck and on the gates to meet the DPH requirements and CDC recommendations. Please take the time to familiarize yourself with these temporary signs
- Please do not share food with other family groups.
- Shared items will be restricted:
 - Pool toys and floats should not be shared with anyone outside of your family. Please take unused pool toys/floats out of the water and keep them near your family's area.
 - Life jackets, floaties and other permanent type items are allowable for shallow end swimming only by one person
- Members must practice social distancing by staying 6 or more feet from people not in your family while in the pool and on the grounds.
- Members must monitor their own children in regards to social distancing.
- Pool deck furniture layout and fixtures are set to encourage distancing. There will be less tables, less chairs, and less lounge chairs than in past seasons. Lounge chairs will be set up in pairs and spaced no less than 6 feet apart from other lounge chairs. **Rearranging by patrons will be prohibited/discouraged.**
 - **Please use provided sanitizing spray and paper towels to clean the Club's chairs before and after using them.**
 - **You are welcome to bring your own chairs as well.**
- Physical barriers and visual cues (e.g. X's on the ground) may be utilized to prohibit gathering. We will monitor, advise and add in any other barrier or feature for the community to promote distancing as identified and needed.
- Please take everything home with you when you leave. **Anything left behind will be thrown away.**
- Please keep in mind that our lifeguard's first job is to keep everyone safe in and around the water. The lifeguards are not responsible for monitoring distance between families nor cleaning up after a family leaves the facility.
- When lifeguard on duty, Adult swim time will be increased to 20 minutes to allow lifeguards/monitors to follow the new sanitizing procedures
- No Pool parties or large gatherings until further notice

Sanitation

- Please use provided hand sanitizer before signing in upon arrival.
- Please wash your hands for 20 seconds or more when entering and exiting the bathrooms.
- The bathrooms will be one person out, one person in. Parents please assist your younger children in the bathrooms so that adequate hand washing is practiced.

ADDITIONAL CONCERNS

- Any and all cleaning supplies, wipes or sanitizer are property of the Club. If we do not have these items, we will be forced to close. Please be courteous regarding these supplies and the amounts that are used. **Donations of hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes or spray are welcome.**
- Before signing in and entering the gate code, sanitize your hands with the provided hand sanitizer.
- A bleach solution may be used to sanitize the pool furniture daily. The pool furniture will be rinsed; however, some bleach might remain. RFSRC is not responsible for discolored clothing/swim suits or towels.
- Leave all disinfectants/hand soap/hand sanitizer where you found them.
Hand sanitizer will be provided near the sign in area.
